The US Army today operates a number of logistics systems to meet its functional business requirements. These systems include systems developed during the 1970's and still serving as the backbone for components of its logistics automation infrastructure. To modernize its business processes and logistics systems the Army developed as its strategy the Single Army Logistics Enterprise (SALE) in 2003.
